Mayor Spicer referred to Engineer Guy Christensen to give an update of the pending Police Station Grant. Mr. Christensen stated that the Village had received an amended copy of the grant agreement for signature today from the Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity, including the amendment to increase the amount from \$325,000 to \$350,000. The DCEO office also stated that a completed grant agreement will be mailed to the Village after the director has signed off. At that time, a request will be made to release 100% of the grant funds as long as there are no outstanding environmental reviews needed. Currently, the Illinois Department of Natural Resources as well as the Illinois Historical Preservation Association reviews is still outstanding. At such time that funding is available through the state and released to the Village, then design and coordination of the project will be initiated.

Mayor Spicer stated that a Christmas tree collection is taking place at the Seneca Village Hall for residents to dispose of their trees. In addition, Mayor announced that still available are bridge shirts at Ellis Ace Hardware which will support the downtown development organization.

Commissioner Timmons stated that due to damage to existing trees at the Seneca Boat Launch, a volunteer has offered to remove the trees from the property on behalf of the Village.
